- QI - have developed survey to interview people receiving services to provide feedback about recovery orientation of agency. CART offering to substitute questions
- CPC - held 2 dialogues in June - observed dialogue at CPSP conference which focused upon relationships between peer professionals and other professionals. 2nd was observed dialogue at seminary. Lasted 2 hours and was very successful. Seminarians, psych residents, and people in recovery. Committee thinking about trying to publish minutes from meeting in professional journal. Looking at dialogue with police?
